END OF SEASON REPORTING

- **Season statistics are needed immediately after the end of the season** to select awards for the Club Presentation Night.
- Marist Cricket Club awards trophies or prizes for significant achievements by individual players, eg hat-tricks, centuries, most catches etc. Accurate statistics are important in keeping track of players' achievements.
- The Club includes each player's statistics in its Year Book, as a formal record for the Club and players.
 - Part of the Coach's and Manager's job is to prepare the team's Year Book entry at the end of the season.
- The Club keeps a record of every player's accumulated career statistics while playing for Marist. These are published each year in the Year Book.
- A summary of the season is to be completed immediately after the last match of the season and sent to the club email address cricket@mcc.act.edu.au .
- A copy of the Season Summary pro forma is attached and is available from Wayne Cassidy (cricket@mcc.act.edu.au) in electronic form. This will be used for the Year Book and/or the Club Presentation Night.
